

PROCEDURES FOR DIVEMASTER ON SHORE DUTY AT FRANCE PARK

Assist divers with signing of release form. Make sure entire form is filled out, signed & dated.

Solo divers must have their own Solo Diving Release in Full (2 pages). They may not be left alone in the quarry. They must exit the water at closing time. Solo divers have a minimum equipment list that must be checked prior to entering the water.

Advise divers of minimum SCUBA equipment required: Tank, regulator, buoyancy compensator, pressure & depth gauges. Diving is permitted only in buddy teams, two or more.

Collect diving fee.

Have diver sign in official log sheet, date and time in. Advise diver to sign out after last dive of the day.

Brief divers on possible hazards in quarry, including but not limited to, overhangs, loose rocks, crevices, landscapes, water environment, iron scrapes in or on the bottom, truck, bus, fishing line, buoyancy course, culvert, trees or other debris, weeds, murky or turbid water, and any and all unforeseen objects, known or unknown.

No decompression chamber on the premises. Nearest telephone is located at the concession stand when open, or the front gate. A cell phone is recommended.

After last dive of the day, divers must sign out.
